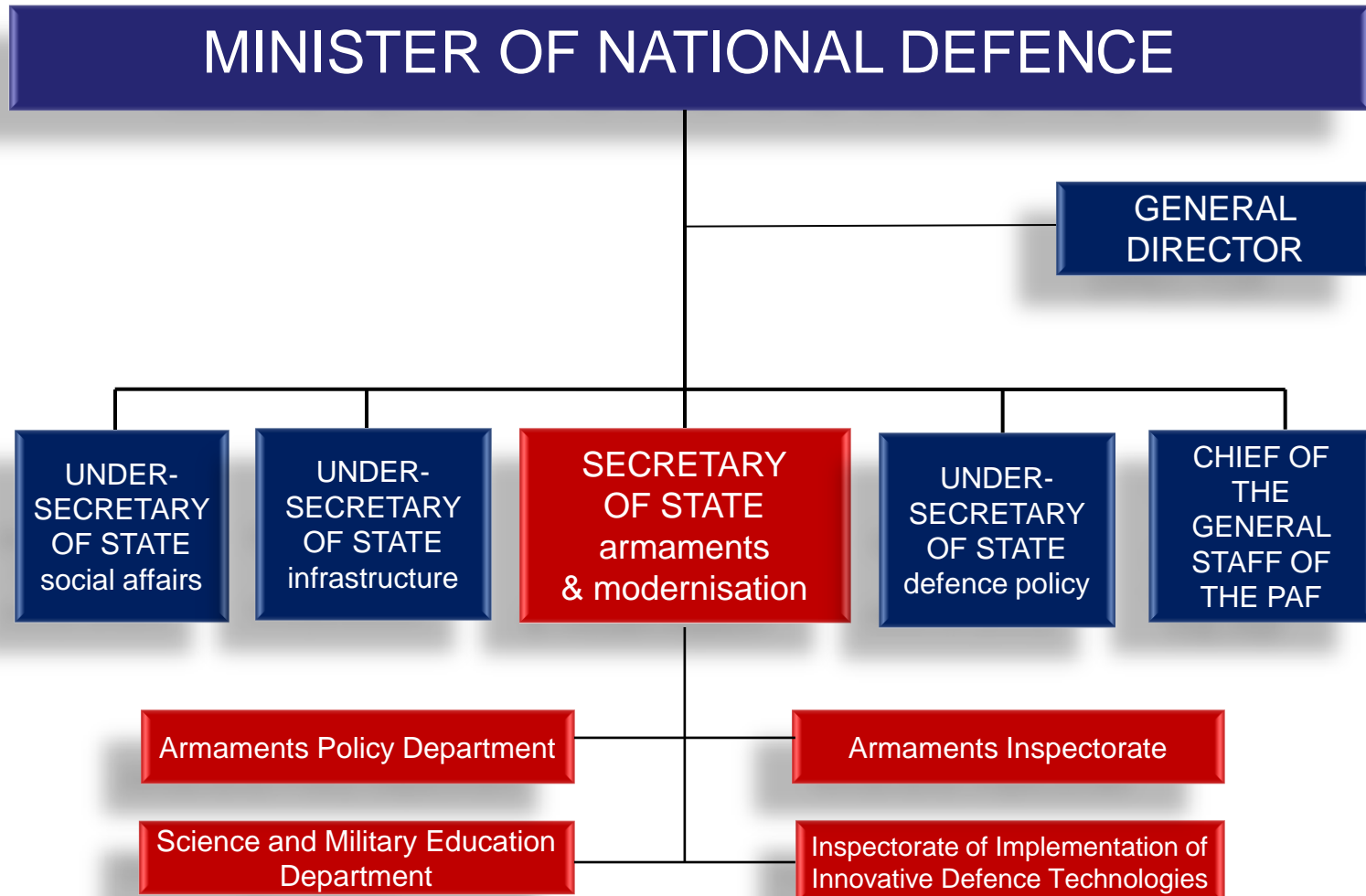

FINANCIAL PRINCIPLES

1. Defence budget no less than 1,95% of the Gross Domestic Product of the previous year.
2. It is estimated that on the technical modernisation of the Polish Armed Forces we will spend 44 bln USD in the years of 2013 – 2022.

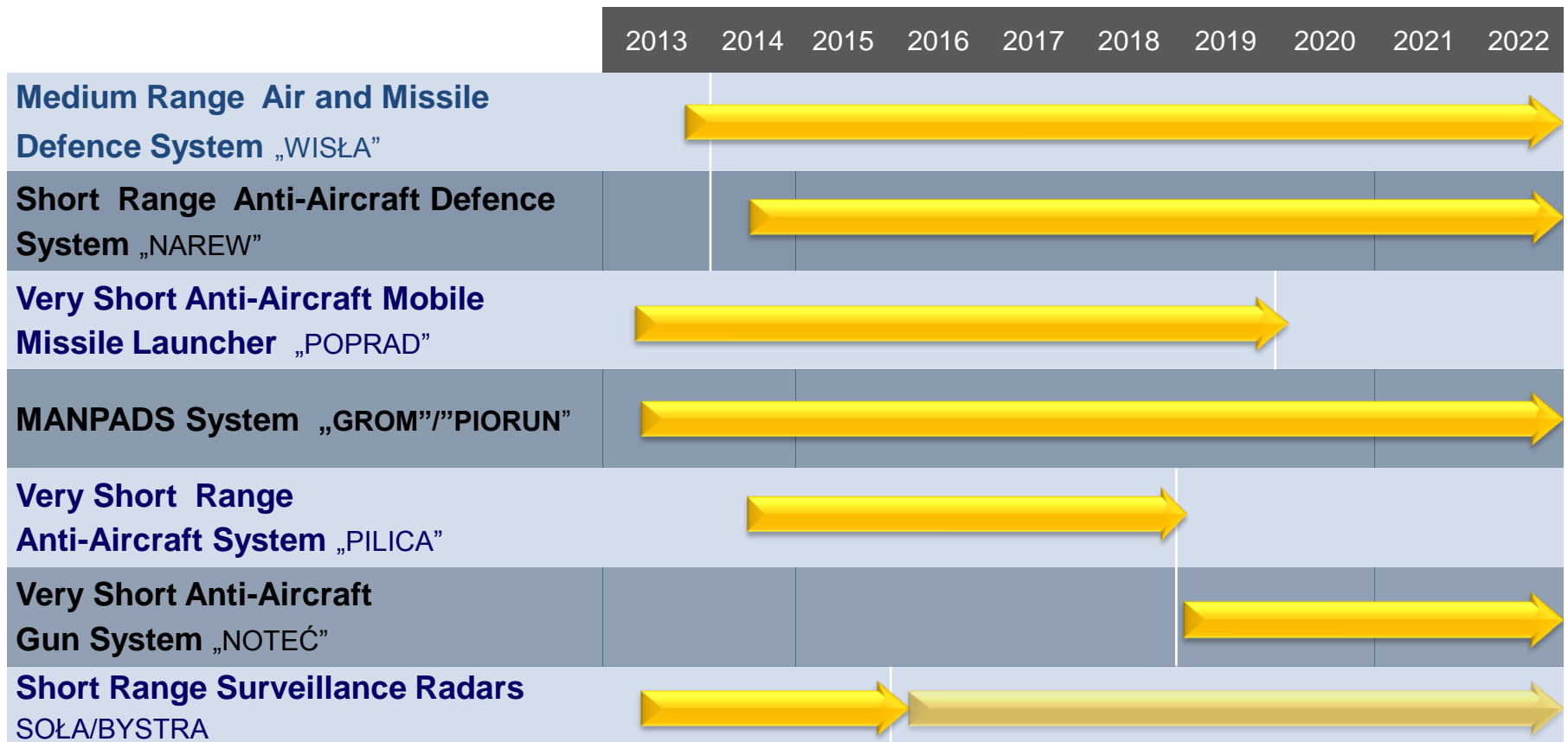

Protection of the PAF units and territory of the country against hostile air assault and limited anti-ballistic missile defence.





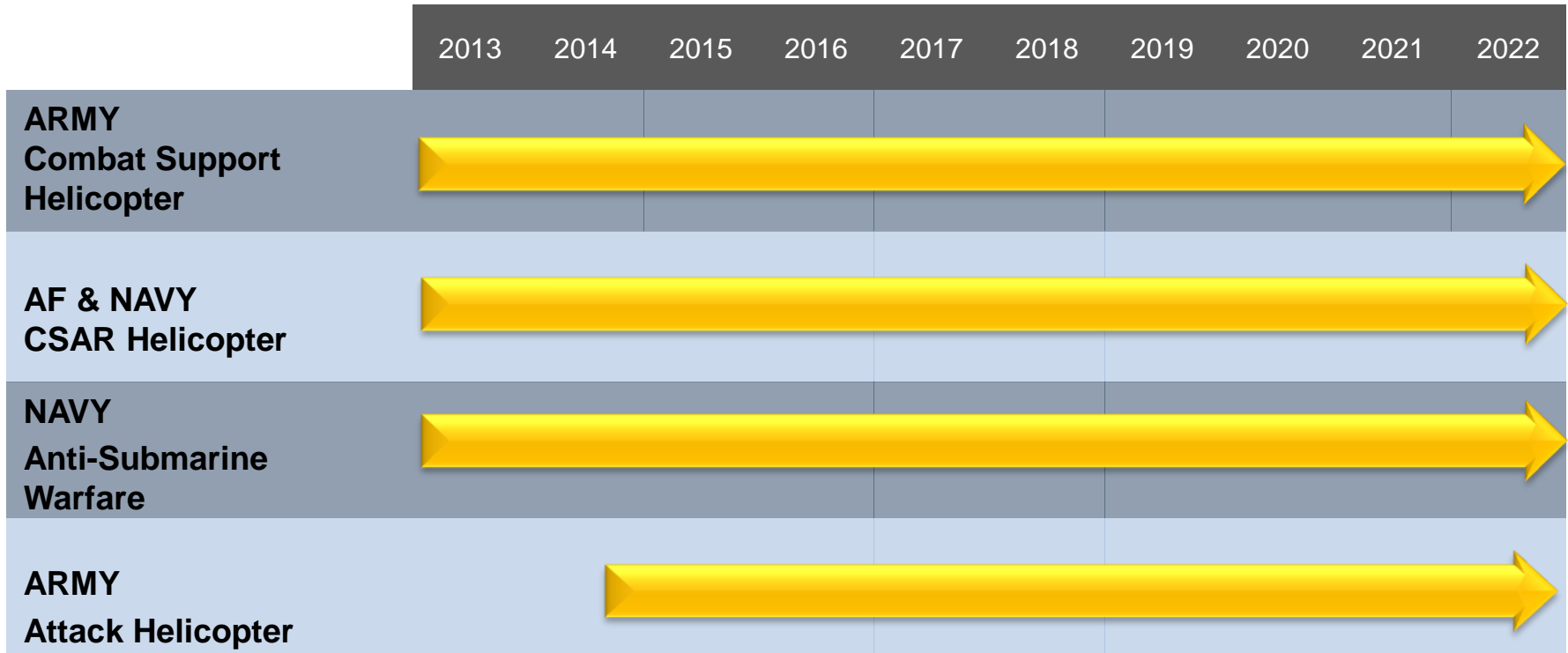

Modernisation of the current fleet of helicopters, procurement of new helicopters for transport, combat support, CSAR and ASW with logistic and training support.





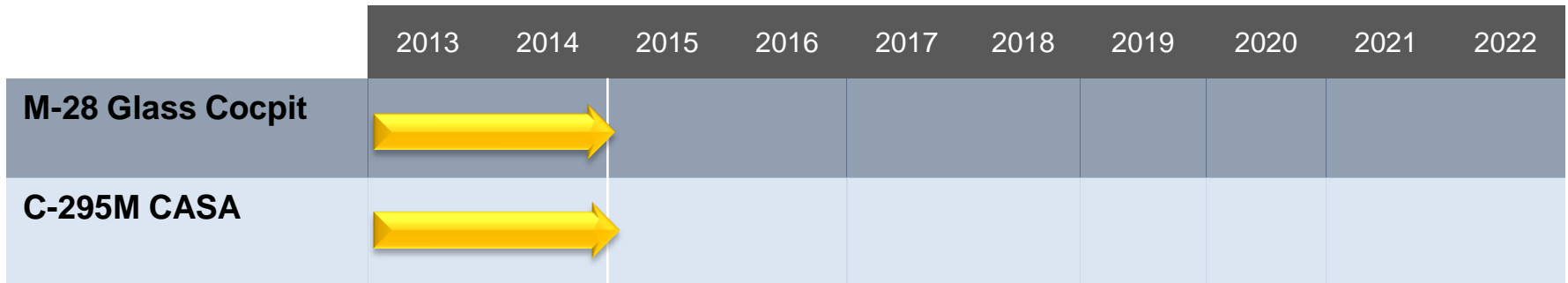

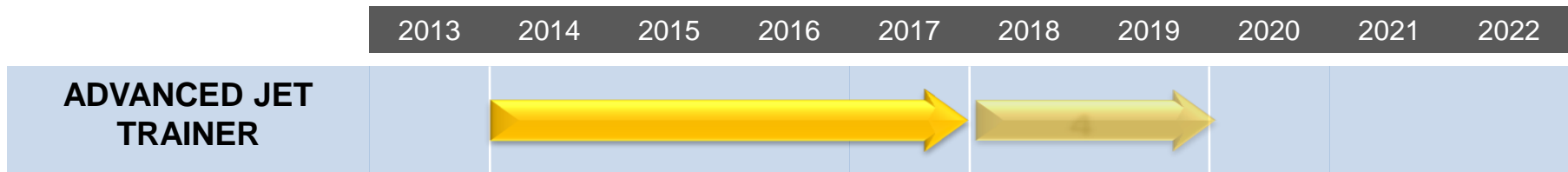


Follow up of procurement of C-295M CASA and M-28 BRYZA aircrafts.

FIRE SUPPORT

Acquisition of batteries with fire modules: 122 mm rocket launchers WR-40 LANGUSTA, 155 mm tracked and wheeled howitzers KRAB and KRYL, multi-rocket launchers HOMAR, fire control systems and support equipment.



APC ROSOMAK

**Follow up of the main contract of 2003. Current inventory: ~ 400 APC with HITFIST-30 mm gun turret and ~ 200 specialized versions.
Plans: acquisition of ~ 300 additional APC's.**

INDIVIDUAL SOLDIER EQUIPMENT „TYTAN”

Development of modern individual equipment and armament to increase soldier's effectiveness on the contemporary battlefield: new battle clothing, protection systems, assault rifle, surveillance equipment and C2 systems. First deliveries from 2016/2017.



PATROL RECONNAISSANCE

Acquisition of light armoured troops reconnaissance transporter and unmanned vehicle equipped with integrated reconnaissance system to collect, analyze and distribute information.



ATGM SPIKE

Plans: integration ATGM SPIKE with APC turrets.

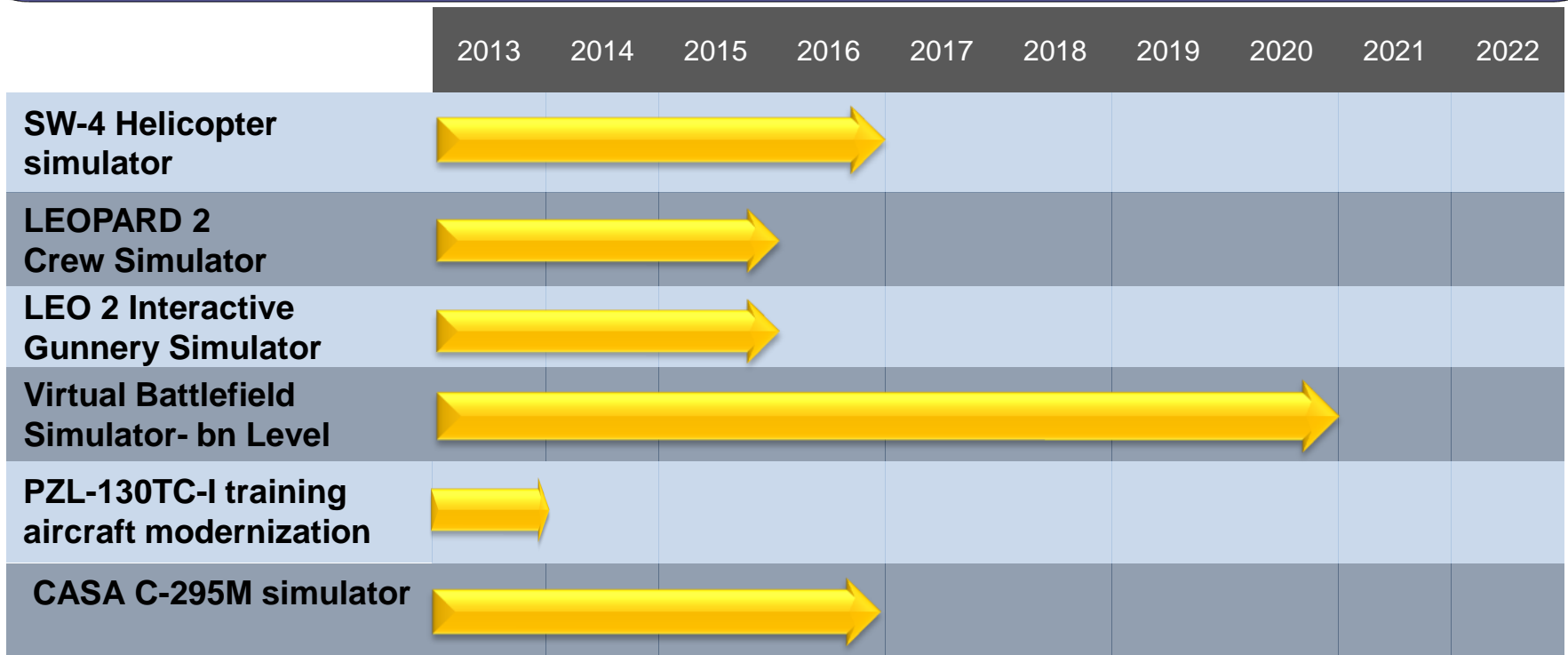

Enhance the effectiveness of battle training. Acquisition of aircraft, tank and battlefield simulators.



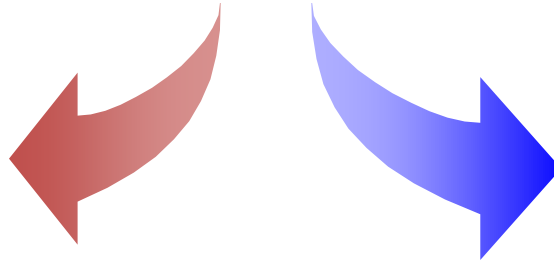
